


LIFETIME FOUNDATION SUCCESSES

Since 1981, AANA Foundation has provided financial support to CRNAs and Residents through a variety of programs. Over the course of its history, the Foundation has awarded more than \$6.6 million to more than 4,900 individuals.

Over \$2.8 million has been allocated to 17 Health Policy Research Studies for total program funding of more than \$9.4 million.



The AANA Foundation's **RISE Above Campaign** was established to generate funding for large-scale, high-cost health policy research demonstrating the safety and effectiveness of CRNAs. Thanks to the continued generosity of State Associations, CRNAs/NAs and RRNAs, new donations continue to support important health services and policy research.

2025 Research Highlights

Two AANA Foundation funded manuscripts were published in 2025:

- "Retaining CRNAs Who Provide Obstetric Services in Rural Communities: Results from a National Survey" (Anderson BL, Sawyer J, Palmer A, Andrilla CHA, Beeson A), appeared online in Journal of Rural Health
- "An Examination of Factors Contributing to Different Anesthesia Models in Underserved Areas" (Palmer A, Sawyer J, Beeson A, Rosner S, Padhye I, Andrilla HA), was published online in April and featured in the Spring 2025 issue of Nursing Outlook.

These studies aimed to:

- 1. Explore the experiences of CRNAs delivering obstetric anesthesia in rural and urban underserved settings.
- 2. Assess how federal policy, commercial reimbursement disparities, and other

disparities, and other systemic barriers affect access to access to obstetric anesthesia.

Key findings include:

- CRNAs consistently fill critical gaps in obstetric anesthesia, particularly in regions with limited maternity care access.
- Hospitals in such areas are 14% more likely to report independent CRNA staffing models.
- In urban underserved hospitals, CRNAs often provide the majority of obstetric anesthesia services—even when physician anesthesiologists are available.
- State policy significantly influences access to care; hospitals in states that have opted out of federal CRNA supervision requirements are 19% more likely to allow CRNAs to practice independently.

Both studies underscore the essential role CRNAs play in sustaining obstetric anesthesia services in rural and low-volume hospitals.

Specifically:

- Low-delivery-volume rural hospitals are 21% more likely than their high-volume counterparts to employ independently practicing CRNAs.
- These hospitals are also 25% more likely than low-volume urban hospitals, and 34% more likely than high-volume urban hospitals, to utilize CRNAs without medical direction.

In Progress:

A Foundation-funded study in collaboration with the Veterans Health Administration is currently underway. This research evaluates patient safety and satisfaction among veterans receiving anesthesia care. The study is expected to conclude in late summer or early fall 2025, with anticipated submission to two leading peer-reviewed journals.

2025 AANA FOUNDATION AWARDS

JOHN F. GARDE RESEARCHER AWARD Nelson Aguino, DNP, MS, CRNA, (Future FAANA 2025 Inductee)

This award, which is named for former AANA Executive Director John Garde, is presented to an individual who has made a significant contribution to the practice of nurse anesthesiology through clinical research. This year, the AANA Foundation proudly presents the award to Nelson Aquino, DNP, MS, CRNA, (Future FAANA 2025 Inductee).

Nelson Aquino is a pediatric CRNA, and clinical researcher at Boston Children's Hospital (BCH), where he has dedicated the past 25 years to advancing nursing and pediatric anesthesia. Aquino serves as the clinical coordinator for the Council of Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs (COA)-accredited BCH Pediatric Certified Registered Nurse Anesthesia Fellowship. He also serves as the vice president of the Filipino American Nurse Anesthesiology Society (FANAS) and was an elected member of Boston's Board of Health during the COVID-19 pandemic, where he contributed his expertise to public health initiatives.

"I am honored to receive the John F. Garde Researcher of the Year Award. My first encounter with John in 2008 at my first annual meeting in Minneapolis left a lasting impression. His kindness, humor, and pride in being a CRNA exemplified his pioneering contributions to our profession and continue to inspire my work today," Aquino said. "Being recognized as a CRNA researcher focusing on perioperative outcomes for vulnerable populations is a profound honor. We must challenge the status quo and utilize our expertise to develop innovative solutions that advance our practice."

Nelson earned an undergraduate bachelor's degree in nursing, followed by a master's degree in nurse anesthesia from Northeastern University and a Doctor of Nursing Practice degree from Seton Hall University. Recently, he was selected as a 2025 Fellow of the American Association of Nurse Anesthesiology (FAANA), a testament to his unwavering commitment to excellence and his impactful contributions to anesthesia research.

RITA L. LEBLANC PHILANTHROPIST AWARD

Jean Gamble, CRNA

The Rita L. LeBlanc Philanthropist of the Year Award is presented to an individual who has gone beyond the call of duty as a supporter of AANA Foundation and other philanthropic organizations. The recipient of this award demonstrates a strong philanthropic spirit, and through his or her charitable actions motivates

others to give of themselves. The recipient of the 2025 Rita L. LeBlanc Philanthropist of the Year Award is Jean Gamble, CRNA.

Among her career distinctions, Gamble was the first female nurse anesthetist to work in Wood County, Ohio. A representative of the Jean Gamble Estate described her as a trail blazer who "paved the way for many nurses in the field of nurse anesthesiology. She was a pioneer in her field and an advocate for patients. Her caring way and her expertise in her field has eased the stress of many a patient."

She was recognized as a community builder who had demonstrated a long history of being concerned for the welfare of her neighbors and her patients. As a passionate champion of education, Jean Gamble's estate recently made a \$400,000 scholarship donation to AANA Foundation as a testimony to the importance of shaping the opportunities for future generations of CRNAs.

Born in 1922, Gamble lived to be 102 years old. She graduated Larue High School in Marion, Ohio in 1940. She later attended Riverside Whitecross School of Nursing where she received her RN in 1943. Gamble was the first registered nurse student in the school of anesthesiology at Ohio State University. She was a CRNA for 40 years, retiring in 1990.

JANICE DRAKE CRNA HUMANITARIAN AWARD

The Janice Drake CRNA Humanitarian Award is presented to a CRNA/nurse anesthesiologist who volunteers and provides anesthesia, education, and training in areas of need in the United States and overseas. The recipient of the 2025 Janice Drake CRNA Humanitarian Award is presented to Michael Hunt,

MBA, CRNA, FNP. As a nurse anesthesiologist, Hunt delivers exceptional anesthesia care, ensuring patient safety and comfort during surgical procedures across diverse clinical settings. His expertise as a Family Nurse Practitioner complements this, allowing him to provide comprehensive primary care, emphasizing preventive health, patient education, and chronic disease management.

"I am greatly honored to be named the Janice Drake Humanitarian of the Year," Hunt said. "I consider it my greatest mission as a CRNA to provide anesthesia services to those underserved communities, and I am proud of the outreach my teams have performed in Kenya." Beyond his professional achievements, Hunt is deeply committed to humanitarian efforts, particularly through his work with Kenya Relief. He has dedicated significant time to providing critical medical care and anesthesia services in underserved communities in Kenya, improving access to quality healthcare for vulnerable populations. He has led teams with Kenya Relief up to twice a year since 2015. His contributions include performing life-saving procedures, training local healthcare providers, and supporting the development of sustainable medical programs. Hunt's work in Kenya reflects his unwavering dedication to global health equity and his belief in the power of compassionate care to transform lives. Hunt has served as past president for Idaho Association of Nurse Anesthesiology and is currently the Federal Political Director for Idaho, a position he has held for the past five years.


