Submission Deadlines and Notifications

Submission Deadline: April 30, 2026, at 11:59 pm CST

Grading Deadline: July 31, 2026

Notification Deadline: All presenters will be notified of their acceptance status no later than September 4, 2026.

Please review the following information before submitting your abstract:

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- Authors are to submit a 30- or 60-minute lecture or demonstration held during concurrent education sessions and should introduce knowledge and/or skills that are immediately actionable.
- Authors are allowed to submit up to two (2) abstracts for consideration (as Primary or Secondary presenter), with a maximum of two (2) presenters listed per abstract. If the primary presenter would like the abstract to be considered as a potential panel discussion, please indicate “for panel consideration” in the Content text box area of the submission process. Panels are not guaranteed.
- Please ensure that all email addresses of the presenter(s) are accurate and associated with the AANA account. Email is the sole method of communication regarding acceptance.
- References should be current and evidence-based, within the last five years. The Committee will exclude abstracts with outdated or inadequate references from the review process.
- To keep the process fair and blinded for the grading process, please do not list any personal information within the open-ended content boxes. Any personal identifiers (i.e., name, title, place of employment, etc.) listed in these boxes will automatically disqualify your abstract from the submission and grading process. Personal data should ONLY be entered within the “Personal information” task which will be blinded during the grading process.
- Abstracts are reviewed and graded blindly by the AANA Professional Development Committee and invited expert graders.
- Presenters are asked to identify any potential conflict of interest related to the content to be offered (e.g., commercial interest, affiliation with a vendor) and affirm that their abstract presentations will not be used to sell a particular product or service. AANA exerts the right to rescind the acceptance of an abstract due to any conflict of interest discovered after the fact.
- AANA will not be seeking pre-conference workshop proposals for EDGE 2027.

AANA will provide discounted registration(s) to EDGE 2027 for the Primary and Secondary (if applicable) speaker of accepted abstracts. Speakers/presenters will be responsible for their own travel costs, accommodation reservations and costs, and any additional fees.

7. Content (400 words max):
8. Teaching Methods (example: audience response, Q&A, interactive discussion): 10-word max
9. Short Session Description (Summary) to be used for Website and Mobile App if accepted (250 words or less):
10. Reference List: be current and evidence-based; references must be within the last five years
11. Approximate time required for content: 30 minutes or 60 minutes. *Requests for additional time over 60 minutes will not be considered.*
