The purpose of the endowment is to increase CRNA volunteerism in the United States and in countries that are in need of anesthesia training, education and/or research expertise. Preference is given to candidates who volunteer in the United States and provide anesthesia as part of their volunteer work.

Eligibility/Criteria for Selection:

AANA members can apply for this award by submitting this Award Application. Applicants must be a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA). Members of the AANA Foundation Board of Trustees are not eligible during their terms of office.

The AANA Foundation Board of Trustees will review the Award Applications, and select the recipient based on the degree to which the following criteria have been met:

- 1) Completed abstract from the applicant describing the anticipated value to be gained by working in a volunteer capacity (not to exceed 1 page). This description should include the use of education or research skills either taught or learned because of this experience.
- 2) The volunteer organization must be approved by the AANA Foundation and be a volunteer program with no religious or political affiliation. Health Volunteers Overseas is an example of a suitable volunteer program for purposes of this award. http://www.hvousa.org/whereWeWork/nurseanesthesia.shtml
- 3) To qualify for this award, the applicant may not receive any compensation from their employer other than the use of vacation days for the time off during the volunteer activity.
- 4) Preference is given to candidates who volunteer in the United States and provide anesthesia as part of their volunteer work.
- 5) Application must be refreshed every year to include current or future mission trip activity.

Application Directions:

Submit the Humanitarian Award Application via email to foundation@aana.com along with the following:

- Abstract The abstract should describe the anticipated value of the experience and be a reflection of your intention to receive funding. Include Applicant's first name, middle initial, last name, complete credentials on first line. No longer than 1 standard page typed (Times New Roman, 11 pt font).
- Evidence of intended volunteer organization and program in which you plan to participate
- Budget with justifications for expenses
- Current curriculum vitae
