

DEI VISION



OVERVIEW OF THE YEAR'S SUCCESSES

AANA Foundation supports critically important nurse anesthesia education and research programs and opportunities for CRNAs and SRNAs nationwide. Thank you to all who have supported the Foundation with their time, treasure, and talent!

The AANA Foundation raises the funds needed to focus on initiatives that meet its research and education mission, ensure efficiency, and provide the nurse anesthesia community with the necessary resources for furthering the profession. Due to the generosity of Foundation donors, the following are major strategic goals accomplished this fiscal year.

FISCAL YEAR 2022 ANNUAL FUND ACHIEVEMENTS

The AANA Foundation's **RISE Above Campaign** was created to raise donations to fund costly, large-scale Health Policy Research that proves that CRNAs are safe and effective. Several important developments have taken place in Fiscal Year 2022:

HEALTH POLICY RESEARCH (HPR)

The campaign to RISE Above for Research In Safety & Effectiveness continues to support critical, large-scale HPR studies to expand the body of research that confirms that nurse anesthetists are cost effective and safe.

Thanks to the continued generosity of State Associations and CRNAs, new donations continue to support important health services and policy research. Since the campaign's inception, nearly \$1.5 million has been donated.

The second workforce publication to come out of the Fiscal Year 2019 Future of the Anesthesia Workforce project was published. The study, "Anesthesia Services: A Workforce Model and **Projections of Demand and** Supply" was published in the November/December 2021 issue of Nursing **Economic\$. Results from** the workforce project were also presented in poster form at ADCE and also as an oral presentation at Annual Congress.

A marketing survey was conducted to assess the perceptions of anesthesia across various segments of the American population including racial and ethnic groups, age, gender, and parent status. The analysis found elevated levels of anesthesiarelated fear and anxiety experienced by Black and Hispanic populations and also parents. Parents undergoing anesthesia have greater fear and anxiety relative to nonparents and also feel anxious their child will be having anesthesia. **Communication between** patient and anesthesia provider helps to alleviate these fears. Results of the study were presented in poster form at both AANA **Mid-Year Assembly and** Annual Congress and also at the World Congress of Nurse Anesthetists in Croatia.

JOHN F. GARDE RESEARCHER OF THE YEAR



E. Jane McCarthy, PhD, CRNA, FAAN

The John F. Garde Researcher of the Year Award recognizes an individual who has made a significant contribution to the practice of anesthesia through clinical research. The AANA Foundation presents the prestigious 2022 John F. Garde Researcher of the Year Award to **Dr. E. Jane McCarthy.**

Dr. E. Jane McCarthy's remarkable career of public service as a scientist, researcher, educator, as well as a clinician, provides the perfect example of how one person can have an extraordinary impact on an entire profession. After completing her doctorate in Physiology from the Uniformed Services University, followed by a post doctorate National Research Council Fellowship at the Navy Medical Research Institute, Jane served in the US Public Health Service Commissioned Corps as a regulatory scientist for the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) reviewing respiratory and anesthesia medical device applications for FDA approval.

Jane developed the congressionally mandated nurse anesthesia program for the Uniformed Services University, one of the first master's level nurse anesthesia programs, mentoring students in their non-clinical and clinical research. She helped develop the AANA Research in Action program, providing a method for students to have their research peer reviewed. More recently she has been mentoring students in evidence-based practice to apply published research results into clinical anesthesia practice. Presently Jane is a professor at the University of North Florida where she does primarily online education in Healthcare Policy and Evidence-Based Practice for doctoral nursing students. Her service to the profession includes serving on the AANA Board of Directors and as president of the District of Columbia Association of Nurse Anesthetists.

JANICE DRAKE CRNA HUMANITARIAN AWARD

The Janice Drake CRNA Humanitarian Award is presented to a CRNA/CRNAs who volunteer and provide anesthesia, education, and training in areas of need in the United States and overseas. The recipient of the 2022 Janice Drake CRNA Humanitarian Award is **Bradford Allen Shelby, APRN, CRNA.**

Bradford Shelby, of Frankfort, Kentucky, has found great purpose using his knowledge and skills as a CRNA to care for patients in need at home as well as abroad. At the beginning of his anesthesia career, he volunteered for Project Health for Leon, Nicaragua. He traveled with a medical team from Wake Medical Center and Eastern Carolina University to Central America to offer otherwise unavailable cardiac surgeries to patients with life-threatening cardiac conditions.

He looks forward to the possibility of returning to Leon with Project Health for Leon this fall to prepare the operating room and equipment for the restart of the cardiac program that was interrupted by the Covid pandemic.

Now living in Kentucky, Bradford volunteers and serves on the board of directors of Surgery on Sunday in Lexington. Founded by Dr. Andrew Moore, Surgery on Sunday's mission is to provide "medically necessary out-patient surgeries at no cost to income-eligible, uninsured or underinsured individuals who do not qualify for federal or state assistance." Bradford is one of dozens of volunteers who give one Sunday a month to share their clinical and administrative skills to change the lives of many people.

A nationally and internationally known lecturer and leader in nurse anesthesiology with expertise in advanced pain management, Dr. Jackie Rowles is an associate Professor of Professional Practice and Director of the Advanced Pain Management Fellowship at Texas Christian University's School of Nurse Anesthesia. Jackie has served the AANA as a volunteer on national committees, task forces, the Board of Directors, AANA Foundation Board of Trustees and scholarship reviewer, AANA President, and Interim Executive Director, and as the AANA Council of National Representatives to the International Federation of Nurse Anesthetists (IFNA).

Along with international nurse anesthetist leaders from over 40 countries, Jackie is working to increase recognition, respect, and educational quality for global nurse anesthesiology. In response to multiple requests for help from global nurse anesthetists, Jackie founded Our Hearts Your Hands, Inc. in 2016. The goal of this non-profit organization is to provide education and educational resources, to train nurses to become anesthetists, or further nurse anesthetists' academic/continuing education so that they may provide high-quality and safe anesthesia services within their country. With the help of generous CRNA donors, OHYH has been able to grant 14 education scholarships to nurse anesthetists from six African countries.

Dr. Sonya Moore's multifaceted career is rooted in service, leadership, and advocacy for her profession and her community. She is an assistant professor at the Frances Payne Bolton School of Nursing, Case Western Reserve University, Director of the Nurse Anesthesia Program, and founding Director of the Leadership Excel and Achievement Program, or LEAP. Sonya is an AANA Fellow, former member of the AANA and Ohio State Association of Nurse Anesthetists Boards of Directors, and Federal Political Director. She influences health policy on a local, state, and national level through lobbying and providing testimony and currently participates in regional and national committees in academia and nurse anesthesiology practice for the AANA and NBCRNA.

Her Ohio-based LEAP program is a transcribable post-baccalaureate certificate program with its first cohort in 2021 for advanced practice nurses specializing in anesthesia. The first of its kind in the nation, LEAP serves nurses from a myriad of cultural backgrounds who were not competitive applicants for entry into an anesthesia program. The program strengthens science and introductory advanced practice knowledge along with the professional and leadership skills of the participant.


